

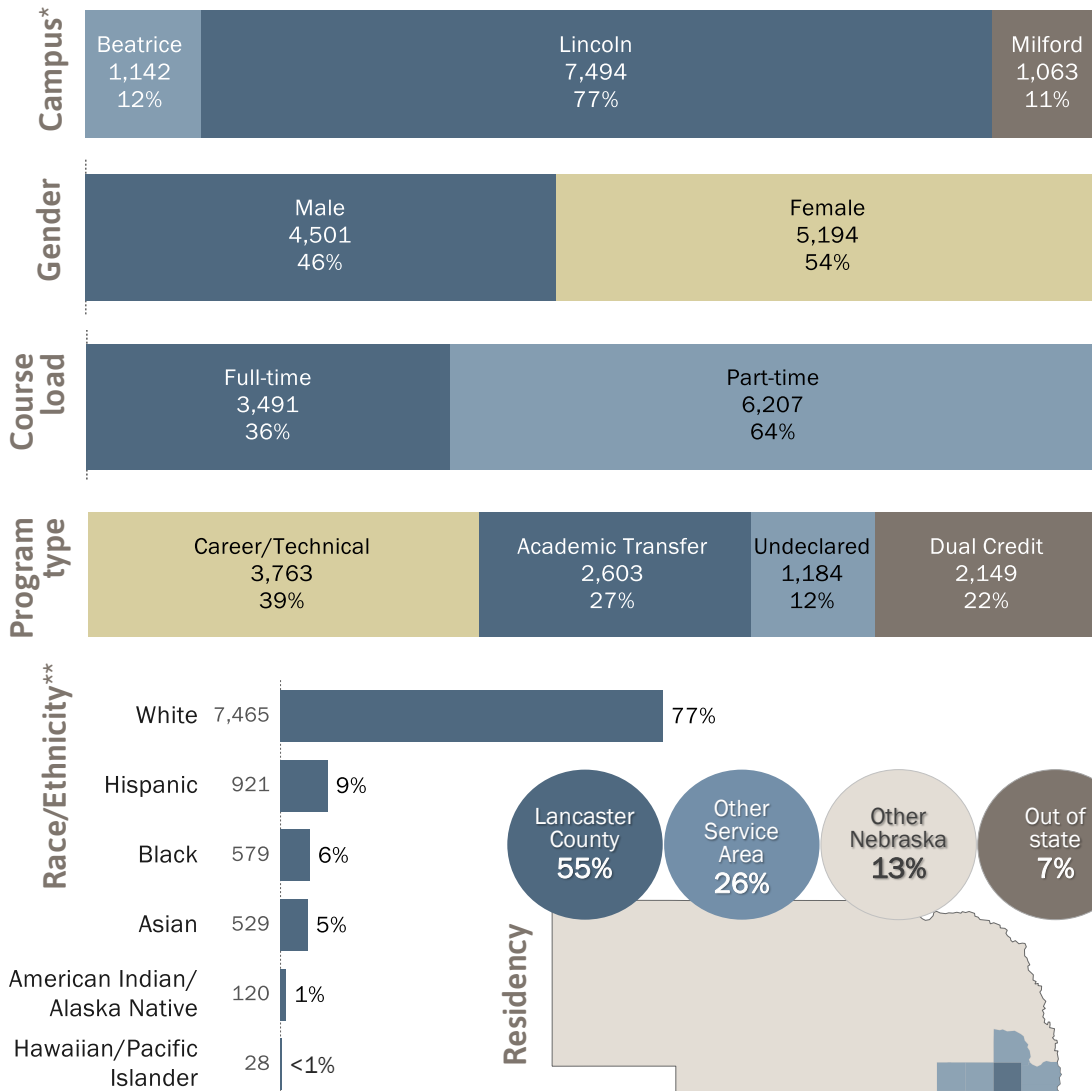
## Mission

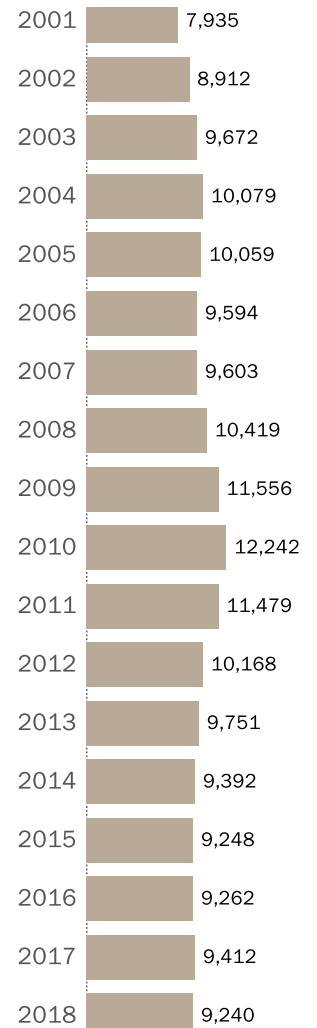

^^ Credit Enrollment charts are based on enrollment at the term census date; 9699 students were enrolled on that date for the Fall 2019 term.

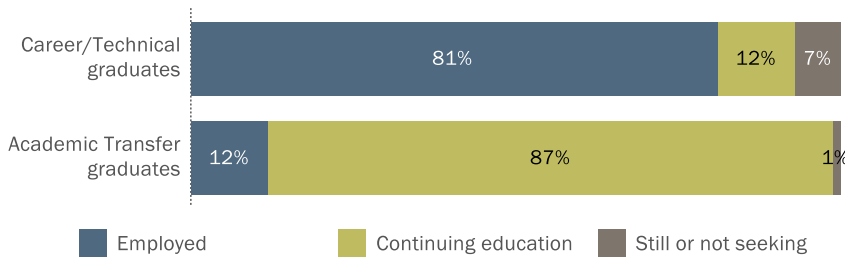

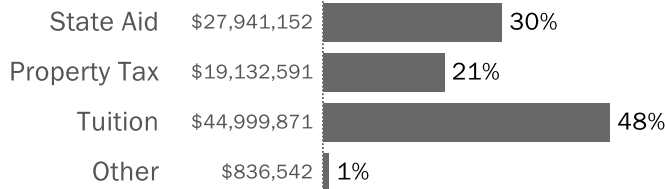
Of the **1574** students who graduated in 2018:

**1226** were in Career/Technical fields      **177** were in Academic Transfer

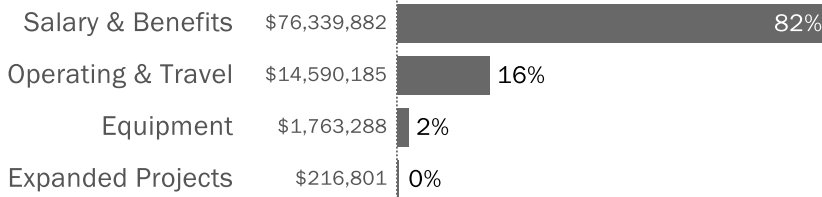
Most Career/Technical graduates are employed, while most Academic Transfer graduates are continuing their education.
