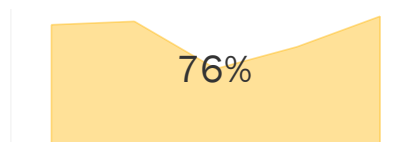

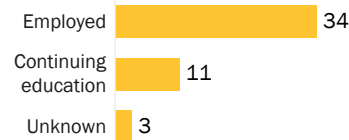

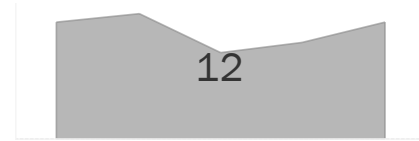

Definitions and data sources

Students in program: Unique headcount of students enrolled in a program associated with the selected unit. (Source: Zogotech, pvt_StudentTerms)

-Full-part: Full-time status of the student in a term. Students may have multiple statuses in an academic year; those students are counted once in each category.

-Age group: Age group of the student at the census date of the term. Students may age from one group to the next in an academic year; those students are counted once in each group.

-Admission type: Status of student in their first term at SCC

Number of sections: Unique number of sections in a subject area associated with the selected unit. (Source: Zogotech, pvt_ClassSections)

Degrees granted: Unique number of degrees granted by a program associated with the selected unit (Source: Zogotech, pvt_StudentDegrees)

Course enrollment: Total enrollment in courses with a subject area associated with the selected unit (Source: Zogotech, pvt_ClassSections)

-Academic level: Academic level of students enrolled in selected courses

-Success rate: Percent of grades in selected courses that were A, B, C, or P

-D,F rate: Percent of grades in selected courses that were D, F, or NP

-Withdrawal rate: Percent of grades in selected courses that were W

Percent graduates employed: Percent of graduates from a program associated with the selected unit who reported that their primary activity after graduation is employment (Source: File used for Graduate Report as compiled by Career Services in Colleague)

-Post-graduation status: Self-reported activity of graduates at or near the time of graduation. Continuing education status is supplemented by National Student Clearinghouse.

-Average hourly wage: Self-reported hourly wage at first job after graduation for students employed in a position related to their degree (i.e., training-related) and excluding those who earned transfer degrees (i.e., AA, AS).

Employee headcount: Unique number of employees on November 1 of each year as reported to IPEDS (Source: File used for IPEDS HR reporting; starts in Colleague)

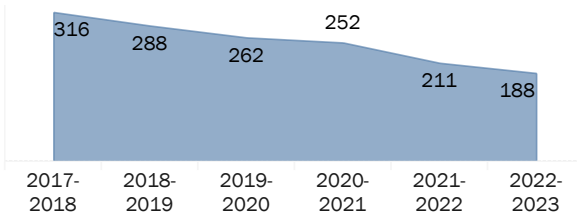

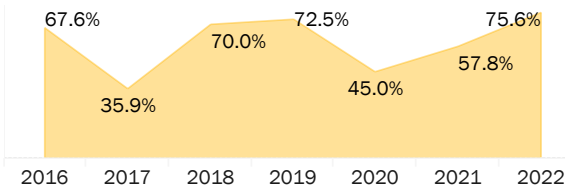

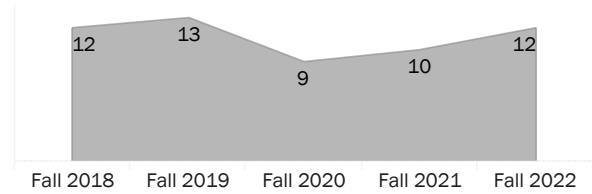
Degrees granted
