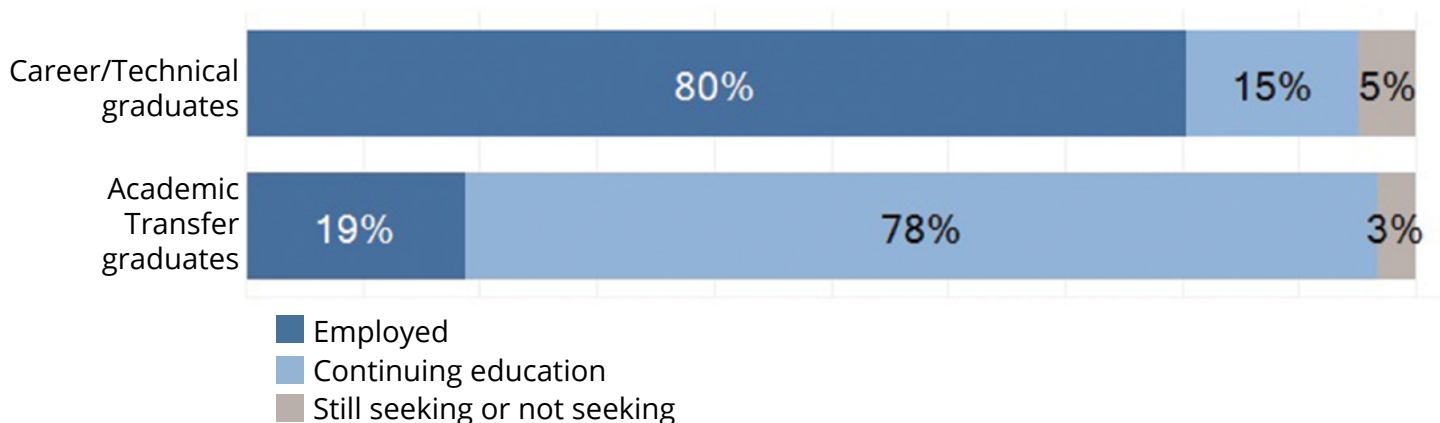

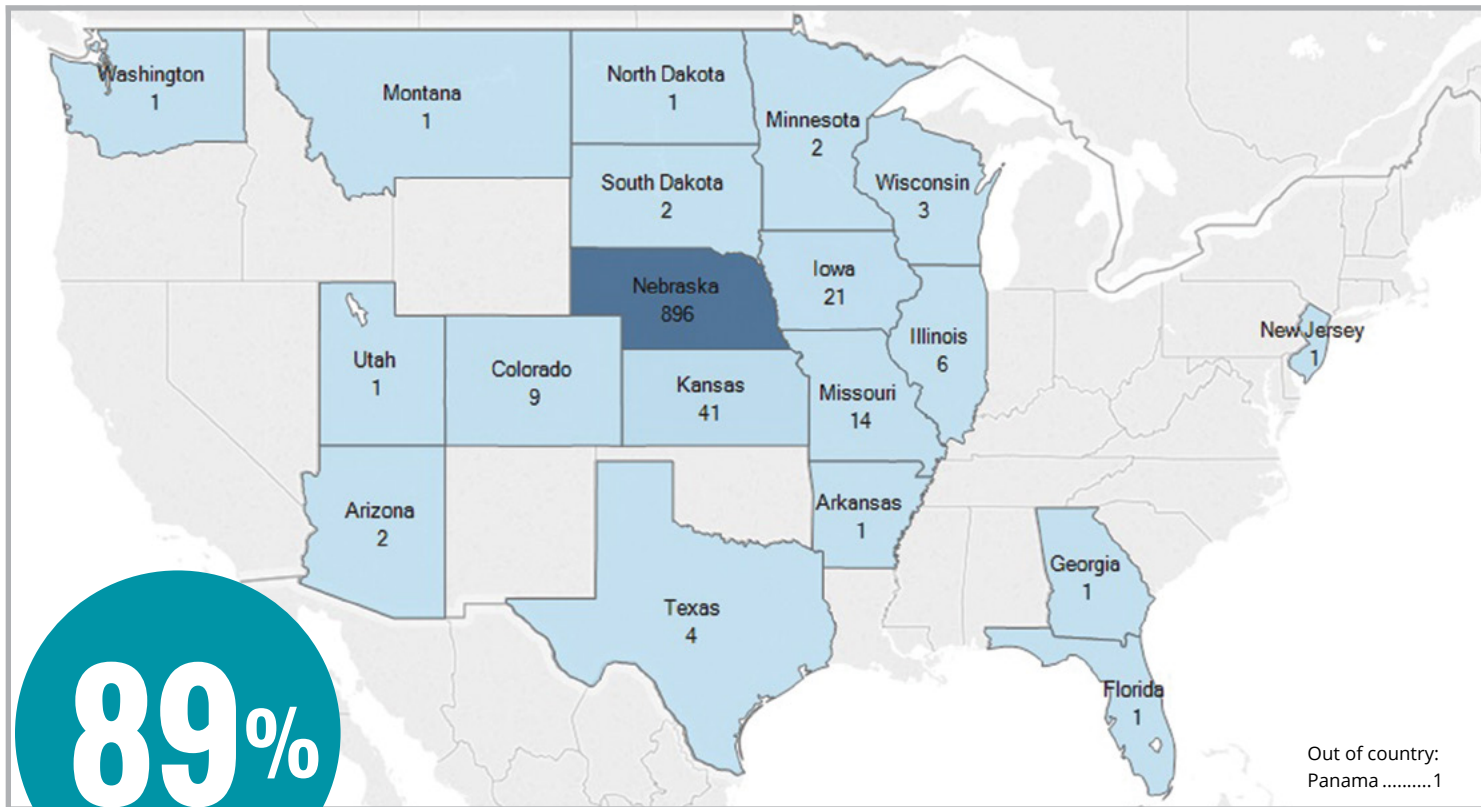
Of 1,497 graduates during the 2016 year, only 4.7% of those who responded were not employed or continuing their education.

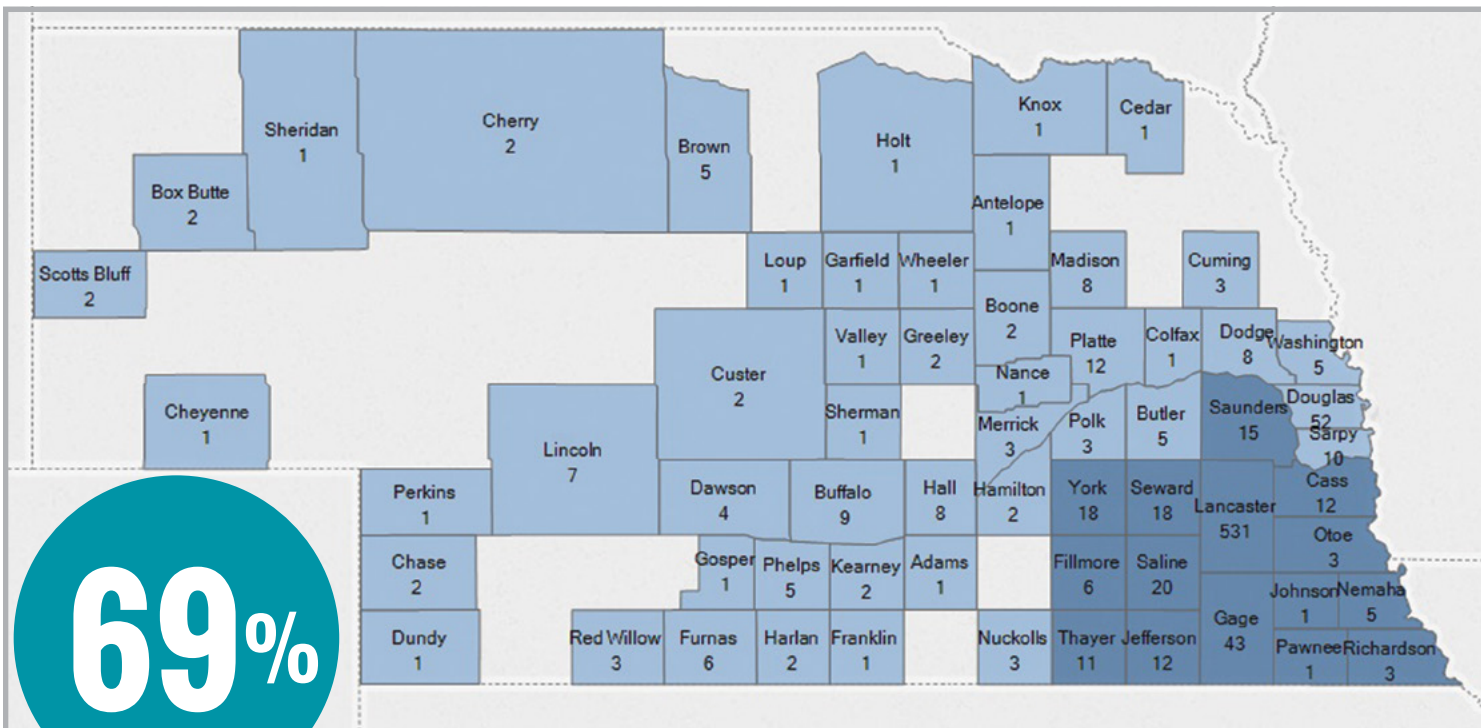

STATE AND REGIONAL IMPACT

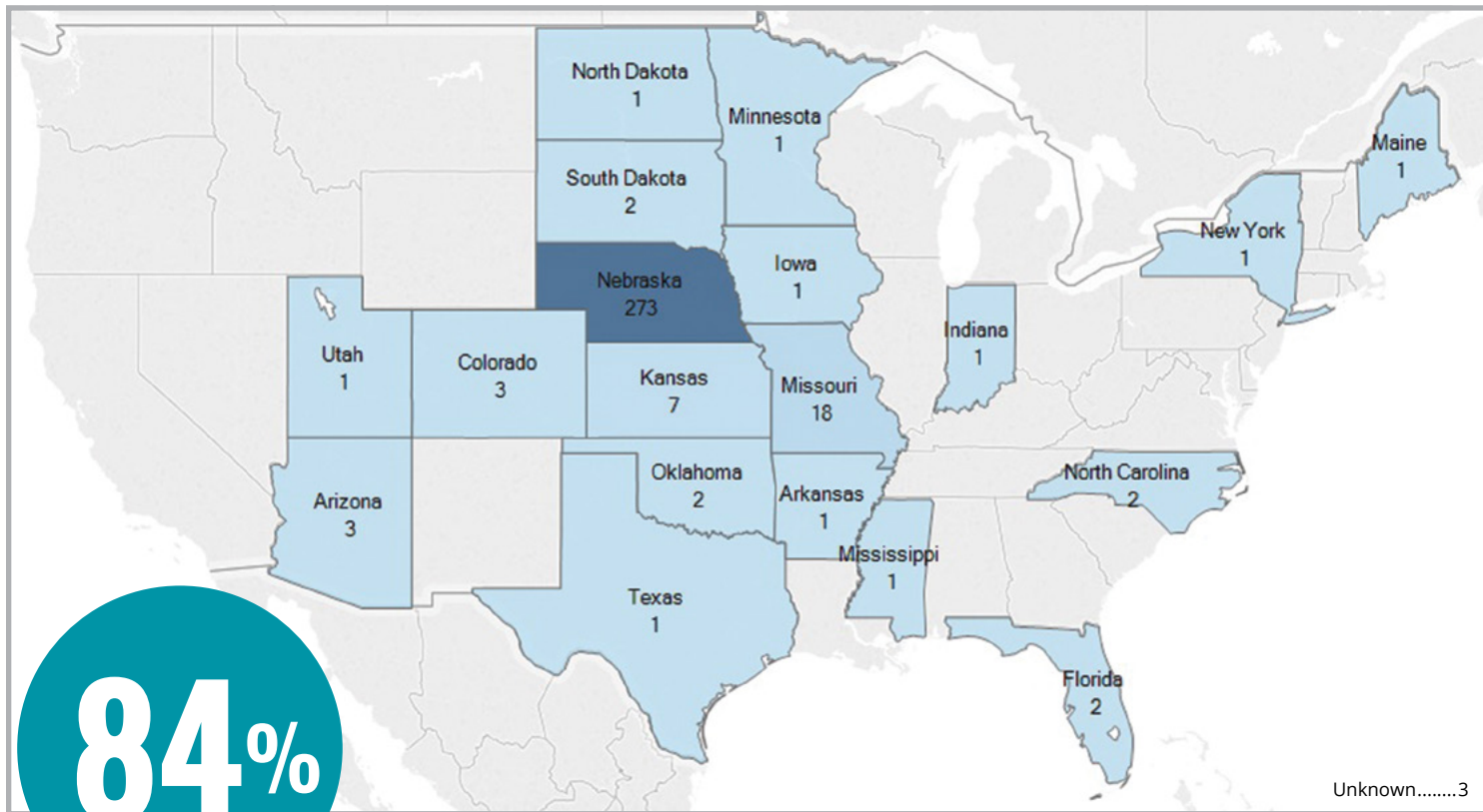

Gathering Data

Information about the post-graduation status of SCC graduates was collected directly from the graduates at or near the time of graduation and from the National Student Clearinghouse. The information at the time of graduation was collected by the Placement Offices through personal conversations, classroom visits, telephone calls, emails, mailings, texts and Facebook.

Wage and employment information has been self-reported by graduates for their first job after graduation. Self-reported continuing education status was supplemented with information from the National Student Clearinghouse.

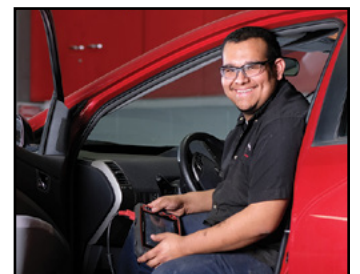
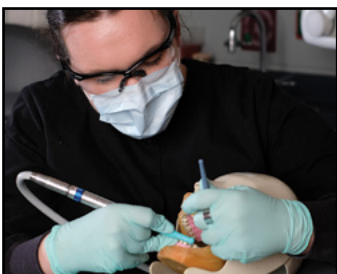
