Financial Aid Application Process

TAX time is FAFSA time

The Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) is YOUR key to financial aid. You must complete a FAFSA each year in order to be considered for financial aid for the following academic year. You are encouraged to complete the FAFSA annually, upon completion of your tax return.

1. Apply and be accepted for Admission to SCC.

You must be accepted for admission to the College and must enroll in an eligible program of study.

2. Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).

Complete and submit your FAFSA online at www.fafsa.ed.gov by the posted "Priority Filing Deadline Dates".

PRIORITY FILING DEADLINES DATES:

Summer 2011 April 1, 2011
Fall 2011 July 1, 2011
Winter 2012 October 1, 2011
Spring 2012 January 1, 2012

Be sure to include the Southeast Community College Title IV school code on your FAFSA.

3. Review your Student Aid Report (SAR) for accuracy, upon receipt.

The U.S. Department of Education will send you a SAR, either by email or US mail, to be reviewed and corrected if necessary. SCC will receive an electronic summary of the information reported on your FAFSA and will begin processing your FAFSA information.

4. Submit additional documentation to SCC, upon request.

The College may be required to verify information reported on your FAFSA. You should submit requested documents as soon as possible to ensure continued processing of your FAFSA.

5. Follow the steps outlined in the SCC Award Notification.

Once your file is complete, you will receive notification outlining your Financial Aid awards. You may view your awards through your WebAdvisor account online at www.southeast.edu.
