

SAP POLICY 2011-2012

All Students receiving federal financial aid are subject to certain policies regarding eligibility and satisfactory academic progress towards an educational goal. Failure to make satisfactory progress could result in the student being placed on financial aid probation or termination.

2011 2012 policy for Satisfactory Academic Progress

- Student's must complete 66% of classes attempted
- Maintain a 2.0 GPA
- Cannot exceed 120% of hours required for degree

Student will be reviewed for SAP after the first 12 credit hours attempted.

If students do not meet the standard they will be placed on probation for a period of one quarter.

Students must complete probation counseling while on probation.

At the end of the probation period the student will be reviewed.

If student does not meet the standard after the probation period, financial aid will be terminated

Reinstatement of financial aid

- Students may apply for reinstatement of financial aid after completing 9 credit hours at the students own expense.
- During this period the student must maintain a 2.5 GPA
- Complete 66% of credit hours attempted
- Probation counseling
- Obtain sign off from an advisor that classes completed are within the student's program of study
- Turn in a completed reinstatement request
