Once thought to be rare and bizarre, we now know dissociative disorders to be relatively common, often misdiagnosed responses to early life traumatic stress exposure. New research shows that, with treatment appropriate to the diagnosis, prognosis for effective functioning is good. This evidence-based seminar addresses best practice topics most relevant to experienced mental health professionals who have had previous training and experience in the treatment of Dissociative Identity Disorder and related conditions.

Participants will:

- *Develop techniques for increasing collaborative action and co-consciousness across identity states*
- *Recognize and be able to use transference, countertransference and traumatic re-enactment*
- *Be aware of and able to respond to boundary and attachment-to-perpetrator problems*
- *Develop tools for management of panic episodes and abreactions*
