**TEXTBOOKS:** Students must read and bring the required textbook to the class. Textbooks are available in the SCC Bookstore.

**CANCELLATIONS/REFUNDS:** To receive a refund, the class must be dropped at least 24 hours before the class begins. We also require 24 hours' notice to change sessions. No refunds will be issued for an incorrect selection. To cancel or switch sessions, call 402-437-2700 or 800-828-0072.
