Nursing Assistant



*This course teaches basic nursing skills such as bathing, feeding, ambulating, transferring, and toileting. This course is approved by the Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services Regulation and Licensure. **Successful completion of this course allows the student to be placed on the Nebraska Nurse Aide Registry.** Nursing Assistants may work in long-term care facilities, hospitals, home health care, hospice or mental health facilities.*

High school completion or GED is not required.

Nursing Assistant students MUST be 16 by the start date of the class.

ATTENDANCE

The first session of class is mandatory. Only register for a section in which you can attend EVERY class. Attendance is required in this intensive course. The Nursing Assistant course consists of 100 contact hours of lecture, clinical and lab instruction. All the material covered is necessary to meet the state requirements and enable you to pass the state-approved exams. Absences exceeding 12 hours for any reason may result in failure of this course. No-shows will no longer receive an automatic refund.

CLINICAL

Clinicals for Lincoln classes are held at long-term care facilities or a hospital the last few weeks of class. White clothing and white shoes are required for clinicals and will be discussed in class. Area sites provide clinicals at the facility housing classes. Appropriate attire will be discussed in class. NO JEANS. Bending and lifting are required for successful completion of certain skills.

FINAL EXAM

You must receive a minimum 70 percent on the final course exam to pass this course. Upon successful completion of this course, you will be eligible to take the written and clinical state competency exams. Successful completion of these exams will allow your name to be placed on the Nebraska Nursing Assistant Registry.

NEBRASKA NURSE AIDE REGISTRY

To be placed on the Nebraska Nurse Aide Registry, the state of Nebraska requires that individuals must meet the following requirements:

- 1) Must be at least 16 years of age.
- 2) Must have no convictions of crime involving moral turpitude.
- 3) Must be able to speak and understand the English language or a language understood by a substantial portion of the health care facility population.
- 4) Must successfully complete a basic course of training and competency evaluation program for Nursing Assistants approved by the Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services.

If English is not your first language, we highly recommend that you take a confidential English language assessment before registering for these classes. There is a \$20 (cash or money order) non-refundable registration fee. To register for the ESL Orientation, please visit SCC, 8800 O St., Room J-2.

CRIMINAL BACKGROUND CHECKS

SCC requires criminal background checks on students taking courses that include experience in patient care settings.

At the first class you will be required to complete an "Authorization and Disclosure Form" and "Abuse Registry Form." **You will be asked to provide a current picture ID, which includes your date of birth (i.e. drivers license, state I.D.).**

If your criminal background check indicates that you have a criminal history, you may be prohibited from participating in the course. A fee of \$45 for the CBC has been included in the cost of the course.

REGISTRATION

*NOTE: Medication Aide students MUST be 18 by the start date of the class. You must be 18 years of age or older to be employed as a Medication Aide in the state of Nebraska. **The first session of this course is mandatory.** Attendance is required in this **intensive course**. Absences exceeding eight hours for any reason may result in failure of this course. You will be responsible for the additional cost charged by the state of Nebraska to complete your licensure.*

Nursing Assistant & Medication Aide Frequently Asked Questions (continued)

What are the prerequisites for taking the Medication Aide class?

- Students must be at least 18 years of age by the **start date** of the class you plan to enroll.

Do I need to take the Nursing Assistant class prior to taking the Medication Aide class?

- No, it is not required, but it is highly recommended. The Medication Aide class builds on much of the material covered in the Nursing Assistant class, and students are more likely to be successful in the Medication Aide class if they have successfully completed the Nursing Assistant class.

What do I wear to class/lab/clinical?

- The first class session, please wear street clothes. Subsequent classroom attire will be discussed by your instructor the first day of class.

What books do I need? Will the books be available at the class site?

- Students must have their books at the first class session. What is the difference between Nursing Assistant and CNA?

- Even though CNA is a commonly used term to refer to Nursing Assistants, the state of Nebraska does not "certify" Nursing Assistants. Your title is "Approved Nursing Assistant." SCC will report to the state of Nebraska all of the names of students who have successfully completed our Nursing Assistant course.

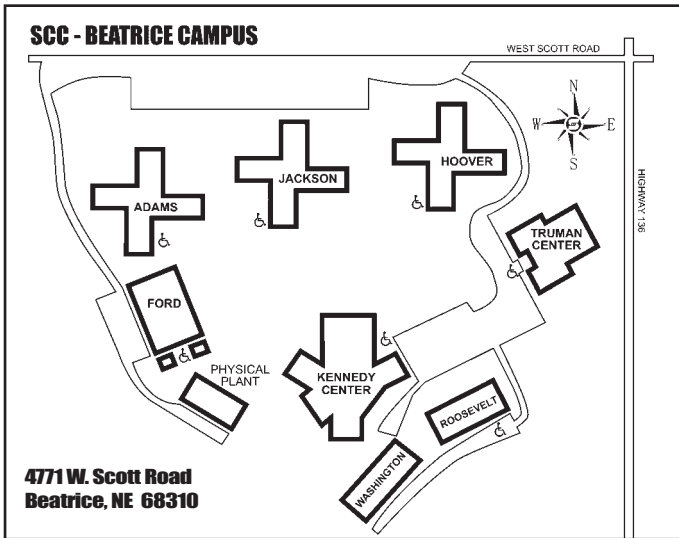
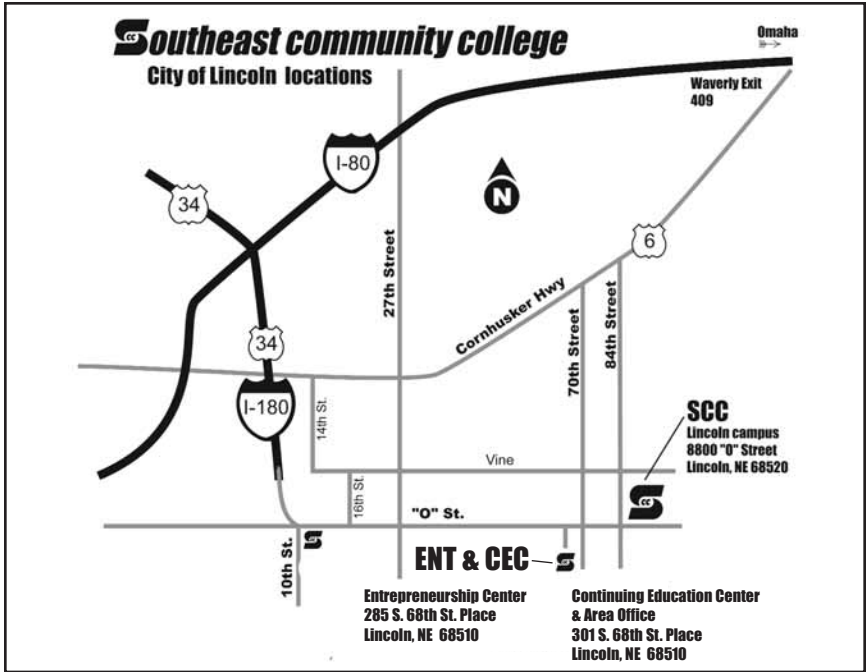
How do I reactivate my status on the Registry if it is lapsed?

- Nursing Assistants who have let their registry status lapse do not usually need to retake the 76-hour Nursing Assistant course. To reactivate their Nebraska Nurse Assistant registry status, they must take both **a written and a clinical competency exam** and pass each exam with a minimum of a 70 percent. They may repeat the exams up to three (3) times. If unsuccessful after three (3) attempts, they must retake the course to be able to work as a Nursing Assistant.

How long will my Nursing Assistant status remain active on the State Registry?

- Registry status lapses if you have not worked as a Nursing Assistant during the past two (2) years. You can retest at an approved testing site, such as SCC, for a minimal fee.

Nursing Assistant Competency Testing Review Lab

This course is offered to prepare Nursing Assistants for the state clinical competency exam. The course will include skills review and practice time. Instructors will be available to assist you.

Nursing Assistant Competency Testing

SCC TESTING GUIDELINES

1. It is beneficial to review before taking these exams. There is a copy of the current Nursing Assistant training manual on reserve at the SCC Lincoln Campus Learning Resource Center or it can be purchased at the SCC Bookstore. You may purchase a skills packet at the SCC Bookstore for approximately \$5.
2. If you are unable to test, you must call the Continuing Education Office at 402-437-2700 or 800-828-0072 prior to drop date deadline (one week before testing) to receive a full refund.
3. WE WILL NOT TEST ANYONE WITHOUT PROPER IDENTIFICATION. You must bring a photo ID with you to take these exams.
4. You must be on time for your clinical exam or risk not being tested. If you are late, you will have to re-register and re-pay. Please report to the SCC Entrepreneurship Center, 285 S. 68th St. Place, Room 109A, 15 minutes before your scheduled testing time.
5. You may take the written exam any time between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. on the day of the exam at the SCC Lincoln Campus, 8800 O St., Testing Center, Room L-3.
6. If you choose to take the written exam before your clinical exam, allow enough time to complete the written exam and be available to start your clinical test at the time you are scheduled. You are given one (1) hour to complete the written exam.
7. You need a minimum 70 percent to pass the written exam. The exams will be corrected within a week of testing. Grades will be available to you the following week. You must call 402-437-2707 for results. You may take the exam a maximum of three (3) times, but only one (1) time the day of testing.
8. Clinical exams are pass/fail. You must achieve a 70 percent minimum grade on each of the six (6) skills to pass. You will be given test results at the time of your test. You may take the clinical exam the maximum of three (3) times but only one (1) time the day of testing.
9. Upon successful completion of both the written and clinical exams, your name will be submitted to the state of Nebraska Nursing Assistant Registry to reactivate your status.

Abuse & Neglect for Nursing Assistants

In order to be placed on the Nebraska Nurse Aide Registry, the state of Nebraska may require some Nursing Assistants to complete this one-hour course. The course involves observing a video, reading material on patient rights, dignity, respect and quality of life. This material covers privacy and confidentiality, communication with others and restraint and abuse. A quiz is given over the material that was read and the video that was observed. Discussion is held on how to report suspected abuse to the proper authorities, both in a facility and in the community. Once the student has completed the one-hour in-service, the state is notified by fax that the student has completed the course and the student receives a copy of this documentation.

This course begins promptly at 9 a.m. If you are late, you will need to re-register and re-pay.
