This class is instructed by an AKC-approved CGC Evaluator and for dogs four months to one year. Providing dog owners with the early guidance needed to get their puppies off to the best possible start in life and set them up to thrive as adult dogs. At the end of this training course, the S.T.A.R. Puppy test will be administered. Passing the test will enroll your puppy in the AKC S.T.A.R. Puppy Program and will receive an AKC S.T.A.R. Puppy package which includes: a formal certificate, an Olympic-style gold AKC S.T.A.R. Puppy medal, AKC Puppy handbook, discount enrollment in AKC Companion Animal Recover, and a subscription to monthly e-mail newsletter that includes training tips.
