Drawing with Colored Pencils

Students will discover a variety of effects that can be achieved with colored pencils exploring differences in quality and grade of pencils and papers selected for drawing. Students will also have an opportunity to review the elements of drawing and composition. During the first class session, students will be provided several exercises designed to help them use various colored pencil techniques, and will be guided through several steps derived from a selection of lessons and demonstrations. Then students will be

challenged to create their own original colored pencil composition.

Each student should bring a set of 12 or more quality colored pencils (brands such as Ticonderoga, Derwent, VanGough or Prismacolor have very good quality selection that have a waxy or oily base for a smooth or creamy color application), a colorless blending pencil, pencil sharpener and a tablet of medium to heavy weight drawing paper. Other optional materials will be discussed in class.
