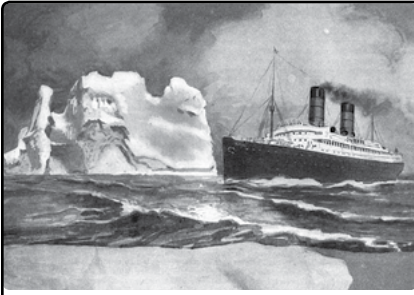

To Register by Logging In:

You must know your **UserID** and **Password** to proceed.
