




★ **"Hands-On"**






Anniversary of the R.M.S. Titanic

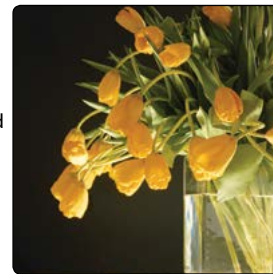


Tulip Time in Topeka Bus Trip
