



Certified Fiber Optics Technician

This introductory three-day fiber optic tech course is designed for anyone interested in becoming a Certified Fiber Optic Technician. This fiber optic training combines theory and 75 percent hands-on activities to prepare the student to take the CFOT test sanctioned by the Fiber Optics Association and given and graded the final class day. This course also introduces the student to industry standards governing Fiber To The Desk, Fiber To The Home, K-12 (schools), and explains Zone Vs. Distribution Cabling.

Students will learn how to identify fiber types; recognize various connectors used in fiber installation; and install, terminate, splice, and properly test installed fiber cable to existing standards. This program explores the history and future of fiber optics and fiber optics capabilities, and cost of installation. Anyone interested in becoming a Certified Fiber Optics Technician should attend this class.

Tuition includes all books, study materials and CD. The text used is, *The Fiber Optics Technician's Manual, 3rd Edition*, written by Jim Hayes. Prerequisite: Basic computer knowledge

Certified Fiber Optics Technician Outside Plant Course

This three-day fiber optic technician course is designed for anyone interested in learning how to properly install Outside Plant fiber optics cabling. This fiber optic training combines lecture sessions and 85 percent hands-on activities to prepare the student to take the CFOT/OSP hands-on and written exam that are sanctioned by the Fiber Optics Association and given and graded the final day of class. This course introduces the student to industry standards governing the installation, testing and troubleshooting of OSP fiber optic cable. Proper Mid-Span Access procedures will be demonstrated during class.



Students will learn how to properly identify OSP types, recognize various outside plant closures used in OSP fiber installation, install, prepare, terminate, splice, and properly test and troubleshoot installed OSP fiber cable to existing standards.

Tuition includes study materials, textbook, CD, and exams. The participant must have successfully passed the CFOT written exam before applying for CFOT/OSP certification.

WebAdvisor On-Line Registration

You must have an e-mail account to register online.

To Register by Logging In:

You must know your **UserID** and **Password** to proceed.

If you do not know your UserID or Password:

- Click on the "I'm new to Webadvisor" at the bottom of the page.
- Follow the 4 quick steps to get your UserID and Password
