- **Credit Classes**

GLST2980 Global Studies – 4.5 credit hours – Lincoln Campus. This study-abroad course consists of interdisciplinary lecture topics designed to address areas of cultural, historical, and major political concepts and controversies that have developed in the target country(ies). The course is offered twice annually if a trip is planned.

BSAD2470 International Marketing - 4.5 credit hours – all campuses. Focus is on theory and strategy involved in the effective development and implementation of marketing strategies in the global business arena.

HMRS1320 Multicultural Competency – 4.5 credit hours – Lincoln Campus. Understanding of self in viewing culture, including dominant and non-dominant culture, power, and privilege. Overview of various cultures and groups.

HIST1810 Survey of Russian History – 4.5 credit hours – Beatrice/Lincoln. Study of four major periods of Russian history – the Kievan era, the rise of Moscow, the Romanov period and Soviet Russia. Emphasis on political, social, cultural and economic characteristics.

HIST1820 Survey of Asian History – 4.5 credit hours – Beatrice/Lincoln. Political, social, cultural and economic development of China, Japan, and Southeast Asia from ancient to modern times.

FSDT2222 International Cuisine – 3 credit hours – Lincoln. Exploration of foods from countries and regions world wide. History and makeup of these foods and their origin.
