## How do I participate in a CAREER ACADEMY?

Talk with your high school counselor when registering for next year's classes to learn how to apply.

You may be traveling to area businesses, other schools, hospitals or medical clinics depending on your classes.

Since these will be college-level courses, you will need to be committed to the rigor and expectations of college.

## AGRICULTURE ACADEMY

To help students prepare for a career in the world of agriculture, Southeast Community College courses in the Academy are:

- ◆ Introduction to Agriculture and Horticulture Technologies
- ◆ Agribusiness Careers
- ◆ Crop & Food Science
- ◆ Live Animal Selection & Carcass Evaluation



## BUSINESS, MARKETING & MANAGEMENT ACADEMY

This Academy provides a broad background that will help students prepare for and explore careers in management, finance, marketing, and hospitality/tourism.

Academy Courses:

## HEALTH SCIENCES/NURSING ASSISTANT ACADEMY

There are **two options** to choose from in the Health Sciences Academy. The first option is comprised of Introduction to Health, Medical Terminology I and Introduction to Sociology, and elective choices such as Anatomy & Physiology and Life-Span Human Development. A second option will be for students to earn their **Nursing Assistant** certificate.



## IT ACADEMY

If you are interested in careers such as Network Manager and Technician, Computer Support, Programming, Web Applications, or Robotics, the following Academy courses are a great way to start:

- ◆ Computer Fundamentals (a college-level class)
- ◆ Logic and Design
- ◆ Programming classes such as Java or Visual Basic
- ◆ Networking classes
- ◆ Web Page Fundamentals/Internet Scripting



## WELDING/INDUSTRIAL MANUFACTURING ACADEMY

For students interested in a career in **welding**, an SCC Academy will provide a hands-on education with classes in Oxy, Shielded Metal, and/or Gas Metal Arc Welding. Students interested in a career in **industrial manufacturing and engineering** will take classes in energy generation and distribution, along with shop procedures and safety.
