No costs are shown for Tools in the 2nd through 5th years, but it should be noted that the apprentice might need to replace tools from time to time due to normal wear and tear.

To determine overall costs, students should plan a budget that includes the above expenses as well as room, meals, clothing, laundry, medical care, recreation and entertainment, transportation, insurance, etc.

Tuition is based on a Nebraska Resident rate of \$54 per credit hour and a fee of \$1.25 per credit hour.
For out-of-state tuition costs, the rate is \$66.50 per credit hour with a fee of \$1.25 per credit hour.

Housing is available at the Milford and Beatrice campuses. Quarterly tuition, books and fees are dependent upon classes taken each quarter. All above options require an additional \$25 graduation fee.
