RE: Important Information for the Student Health Statement

You have applied for or expressed an interest in a health program offered at Southeast Community College. One of the requirements that must be completed for any health program is a Student Health Statement. The clinical sites require all students entering a health program be fully immunized. This form will provide documentation of your immunizations and titer results. A Physician, Physician's Assistant or Registered Nurse must sign the form.

If you cannot provide a completed Student Health Statement due to lack of records, titers (blood draws), will need to be done. Students can go to Physician's Laboratory Services, Inc. to have titers done at a discounted rate of \$55. Please see the attached form for directions on having titers done. Students under the age of 19 must have a parental/guardian signature. Titers cannot be done for Tdap (Tetanus, Diphtheria and Pertussis) or Tuberculosis (TB). Tdap is a vaccination and TB is a skin test that must be documented on the Student Health Statement.

We are now requiring a two-step Tuberculosis skin test. You need to get the first TB test and if the results come back negative, you need to get the second TB test 1-3 weeks after the first test was read. If you have had a TB test within the last 12 months and the results were negative, you are only required to have one more TB test and will not have to have two.

If any titer comes back as negative or equivocal (neither negative nor positive), further immunizations are required. If you can provide records that you have had the immunizations, you will only need to get a booster for that specific disease. If not, you will need to receive the vaccinations.

If you are using Physician's Laboratory Services, Inc., you must hold on to the Student Health Statement until you receive a copy of your results. SCC should receive the results about the same time. Once you receive your results, you may submit the Student Health Statement to the Admissions Office. We will then match the Student Health Statement to SCC's copy of your titer results. You may contact the Admissions office at 402-437-2600 to confirm we have received our copy of your titer results.

You will want to keep your copy of the titer results as you may be required to present them to the clinical sites. Our office will give you the yellow copy of your Student Health Statement to also keep for your records.

**We will not accept the Student Health Statement if any portion is left incomplete. Personal health records will not be accepted in place of the Student Health Statement.** If you have questions regarding the Student Health Statement or using Physician's Laboratory Services, please contact Admissions at 402-437-2600 or 800-642-4075 ext. 2600.
