Eligibility Requirements

YOU MUST:

1. Live on the North Side of "O"
2. Be at least 18 years of age and fall into **one** of the following categories:
 - A. Currently Unemployed
 - B. High School Dropout
 - C. Past Criminal Record
 - D. Low -income (150% of poverty level)
 - E. Veteran or veteran's spouse if otherwise qualified



This Recovery Act-Pathways out of Poverty program is 100% funded by the Workforce Investment Act and the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009. The total Federal investment for this program is \$2,331,278.

In addition to construction training, take advantage of these free classes:

- **ESL** (English as a Second Language) - classes to help you increase English reading and writing skills
- **VESL** (Vocational ESL) - classes to help you learn English vocabulary and other information needed for computer and construction classes
- **Computer Classes** - introductory lessons in keyboarding, Microsoft Word, Excel, Internet, and E-mail
- **Basic Education/GED** – classes to improve reading, math, progress toward your **GED** and help you qualify for the Construction courses
- **Job Skills and Money Smarts classes** – how to get and keep a job; how to manage money, checking accounts, and more
