Estimate based on minimum of 90 hours for Associate of Arts or Associate of Science Degree at an average of 15 hours per quarter. Full-time students may take anywhere from 12 to 18 hours per quarter. Students with specific transfer plans may choose to take more or fewer total hours. Estimate does not include developmental courses. Book estimates based on price of new textbooks.

To determine overall costs, students should plan a budget that includes the above expenses as well as room, meals, clothing, laundry, medical care, recreation and entertainment, transportation, insurance, etc.

Tuition is based on a Nebraska Resident rate of \$47 per credit hour and a fee of \$1 per credit hour. For out-of-state tuition costs, the rate is \$57.50 per credit hour with a fee of \$1 per credit hour.
