

## Take Notice – Important Immunization Information

**Health Statement Only:** Complete entire form and have a Physician, Physician Assistant, or a Registered Nurse sign the health statement. Include name of office/group, as well as address/ phone information, and turn original into the Admissions Office.

**Titer information:** If a student cannot provide a completed health statement due to lack of records, titers will need to be done. Follow the directions provided by Physicians Laboratory Services, Inc. (see attached form). Students under the age of 19 years must have a parental/guardian signature giving permission to have blood drawn at Physicians Laboratory Services Inc. for the immunization panel. **Tetanus, diphtheria, pertussis, and tuberculosis need to be documented on the Student Health Statement – titers are not possible.**

Student keeps the Health Statement until titer results are complete. Once the student receives a copy of the Student Immunization Panel from Physicians Laboratory Services, Inc. he/she will need to bring in the Student Health Statement to the Admissions Office. SCC will then match it to the college's copy of the Student Immunization Panel. Feel free to contact the Admissions Office to confirm SCC has received our copy of the Student Immunization Panel, which will allow you to bring in your health statement to complete your health requirement.

**Student should retain a copy of the Student Health Statement and Student Immunization Panel if applicable. You may be requested by your clinical site to provide a copy of the document(s) in the future.**
