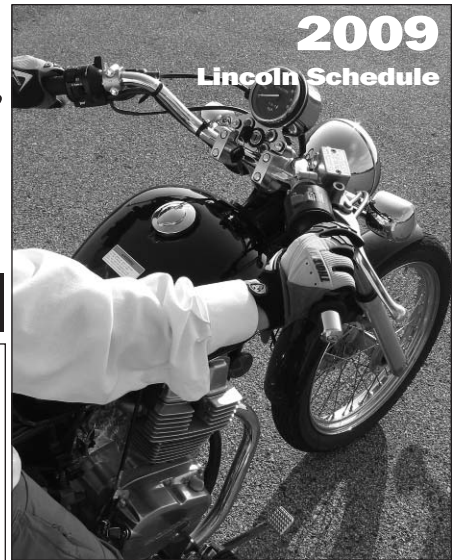




Motorcycle Safety

- Obstacles and lane changes
- Avoiding hazards

Enrollment is limited to 12 students per class.
Tuition: \$160

Students must successfully complete both the written and driving exams to receive documentation for the motorcycle endorsement.

Prerequisite: Student must be 18 and able to ride a bicycle.

Students must provide their own:

- Dept. of Transportation approved helmet & eye protection
- over-the-ankle footwear
- long-sleeve shirt or jacket
- long non-flare denim pants or equivalent
- full-fingered gloves, preferably leather

SCC will provide the motorcycles.

All SCC instructional staff is MSF Certified and approved by the state of Nebraska.
