NOTE: Book cost is the TOTAL for the program. Books for general education classes may have been purchased prior to starting the program. All remaining books should be purchased at the time of entry into the first nursing course.

To determine overall costs, students should plan a budget that includes the above expenses as well as room, meals, clothing, laundry, medical care, recreation and entertainment, transportation, insurance, etc.

Tuition is based on a Nebraska Resident rate of \$47 per credit hour and a fee of \$1 per credit hour.
For out-of-state tuition costs, the rate is \$57.50 per credit hour with a fee of \$1 per credit hour.
