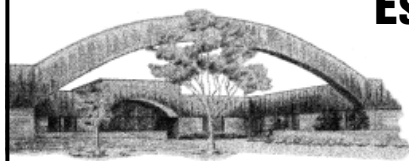


DISTANCE SURGICAL TECHNOLOGY

The following information is provided to help students estimate the total cost of the Distance Surgical Technology Program. Nonresident or out-of state tuition is \$57.50 per credit hour per term.

Additional Related Expenses

Scrub Clothes (2 sets) \$75/pair

Good Athletic or Walking Shoes \$35-65
(Must be enclosed toe, leather or plastic clogs are acceptable.)

Safety Goggles (nonprescription) \$15-20

The total cost per quarter pertains only to Surgical Technology courses. General education courses (designated by * on curriculum list) will be taken at the community college in your area. The cost for the general education courses will be determined by the cost of tuition and fees of that college and the cost of the books.

To determine overall costs, students should plan a budget that includes the above expenses as well as room, meals, clothing, laundry, medical care, recreation and entertainment, transportation, insurance, etc.

Tuition is based on a Nebraska Resident rate of \$47 per credit hour and a fee of \$1 per credit hour. For out-of-state tuition costs, the rate is \$57.50 per credit hour with a fee of \$1 per credit hour.
