The SCC scholarship committee will select the recipients. Scholarship recipients will be notified via e-mail.

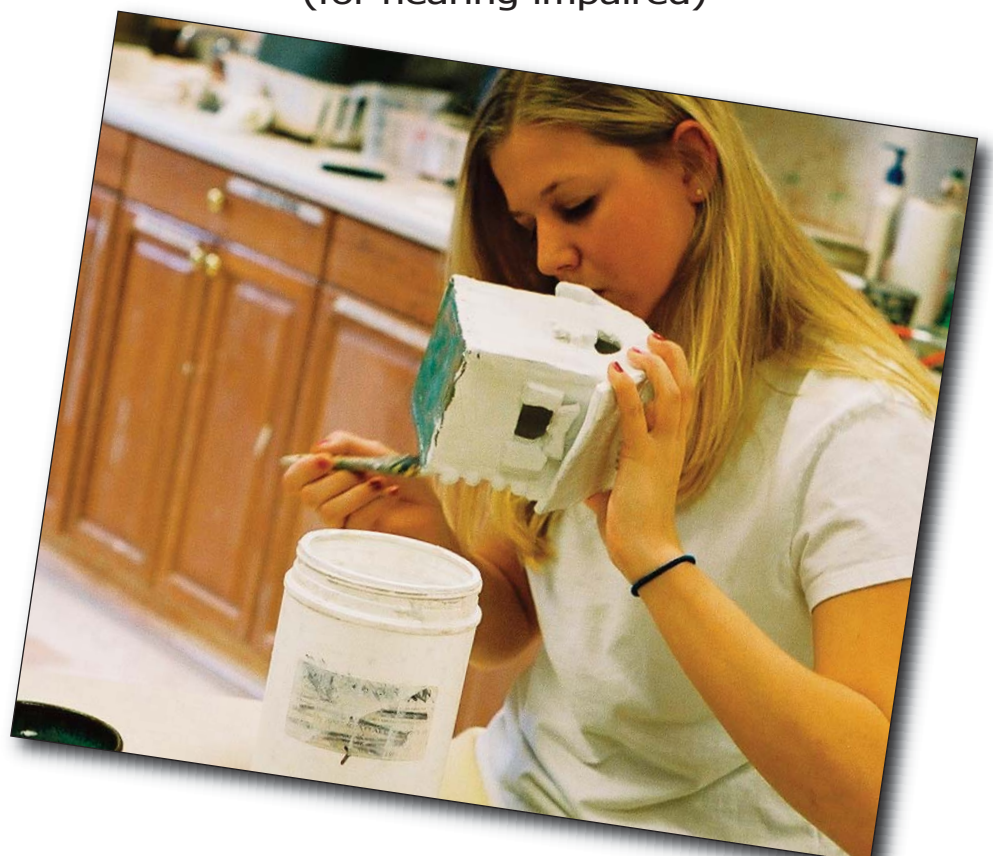
Application

 - a copy of his/her high school transcript which must include: 1) class rank 2) cumulative GPA
