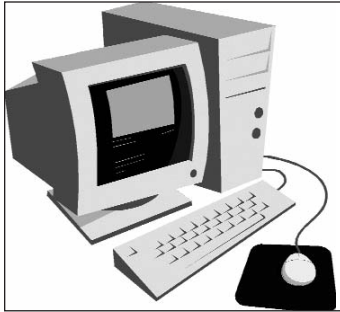




# HOMESTEAD COMPUTER WORKSHOPS

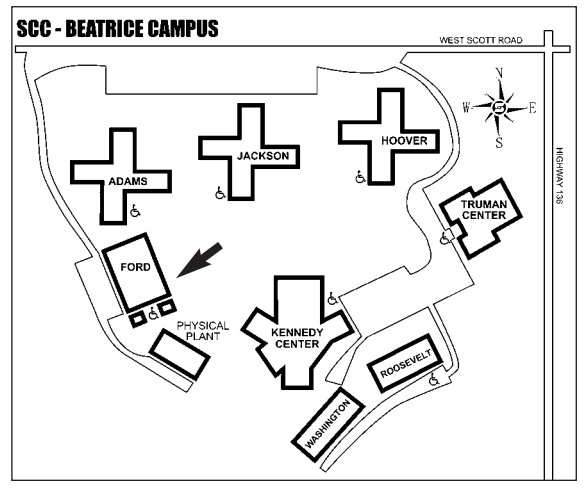
**Continuing Education**
