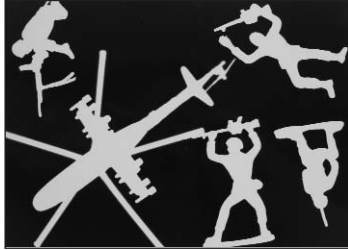

Dark Room Fun – Photograms

Have you ever wondered what it is like to work in a traditional photography darkroom? Join SCC instructor Elizabeth England and learn about the darkroom while making photograms. A photogram is a photographic image made without a camera. You will be placing objects directly onto light-sensitive photo paper, exposing them to light and then developing the paper. The result is a negative shadow image varying in tone. You will transform common objects into art. No camera or negatives are needed. Students will take home their finished photograms.



This class is appropriate for adult and child or adult only. Minimum age requirement is 8 years. Tuition includes all supplies and use of the darkroom facilities.

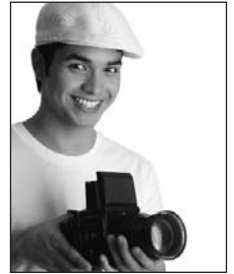
Photography & The Adjustable Camera

Shoot, Develop & Print—Black & White Photos

Come play in the darkroom! This class is for those students who appreciate the traditional black and white photos and want to learn how to do it themselves. Students will take pictures on their own 35mm camera and then learn how to develop 35mm film and turn their negatives into sharp, frame-worthy photos to display and cherish. Each student will need to have their own 35mm camera. We will spend a brief period of time on basic instruction. Then we will spend the majority of time in the darkroom turning your own snapshots into art. Each student will take home their negatives, a negative proof page, and a minimum of three fantastic photos edited and printed! Each student also will leave with a new appreciation of traditional black and white film developing and printing. There will be a limited number of spots available, so register early.
