“Southeast community college – Lincoln Campus

The following information is provided to help students estimate the total cost of attending Southeast Community College–Lincoln Campus. Amounts are based on full-time enrollment.

■ In-Home Child Care Certificate

This focus requires 36 quarter credits to graduate. Based on completing an average of 12 credits each quarter, this program will take approximately three quarters to complete. Quarterly tuition, books, and fees will be dependent upon classes taken each quarter.

In-Home Child Care

Additional \$25 fee for graduation.
(average quarterly total = \$988.67 for 3 qrt.)

■ Child Care Professional Diploma

This focus requires 83 quarter credits to graduate. Based on completing an average of 15 credits each quarter, this program will take approximately six quarters to complete. Quarterly tuition, books and fees will be dependent upon classes taken each quarter.

Child Care Professional

Additional \$25 fee for graduation.
(average quarterly total = \$1,049.17 for 6 qrt.)

■ Early Childhood Education Associate of Applied Science Degree

This degree requires 119.5 quarter credits to graduate. Based on completing an average of 15 credits each quarter, this program will take approximately eight quarters to complete. Quarterly tuition, books, and fees will be dependent upon classes taken each quarter.

Early Childhood Education

Additional \$25 fee for graduation.
(average quarterly total = \$1,023.63 for 8 qrt.)

To determine overall costs, students should plan a budget that includes the above expenses as well as room, meals, clothing, laundry, medical care, recreation and entertainment, transportation, insurance, etc.

Tuition is based on a Nebraska Resident rate of \$47 per credit hour and a fee of \$1 per credit hour.
For out-of-state tuition costs, the rate is \$57.50 per credit hour with a fee of \$1 per credit hour.
