Upon graduation students are eligible to take the MA certification exam. If this is done within one year of graduation, the fee is \$120.

To determine overall costs, students should plan a budget that includes the above expenses as well as room, meals, clothing, laundry, medical care, recreation and entertainment, transportation, insurance, etc.

Tuition is based on a Nebraska Resident rate of \$47 per credit hour and a fee of \$1 per credit hour. For out-of-state tuition costs, the rate is \$57.50 per credit hour with a fee of \$1 per credit hour.
