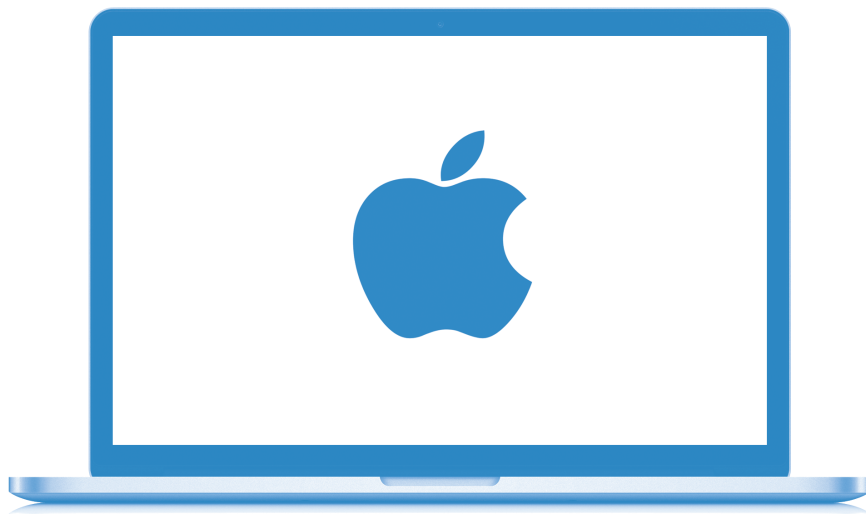




LAPTOP REQUIREMENT

You are required to purchase an industry standard laptop when you begin the Graphic Design & Media Arts program. Within this document is information about this requirement.



Mac Specifications

- Multicore Intel processor with 64-bit support
- Mac OS X v10.8, 10.9
- 4 GB of RAM (8 GB recommended)
- Minimum of 100 GB hard disk space
- 1440 x 900 display or larger with 32-bit video card
- 7200-RPM hard drive
- OpenGL 2.0-capable system

Windows Specifications

- Intel Pentium 4 or AMD Athlon 64 Processor (2 GHz or faster)
- Microsoft Windows 7 with Service Pack 1, Windows 8, or Windows 8.1, Windows 10
- At least 13-inch display
- 4 GB of RAM (8 GB recommended)
- Minimum of 100 GB hard disk space
- 1280 x 1080 display or larger with 32-bit video card
- 7200-RPM hard drive
- OpenGL 2.0-capable system



! Please note: Many GD|MA instructors are trained and work exclusively on Mac computers. Due to this, instructors may not be able to assist with PC/Windows troubleshooting.

Why the requirement?

Buying a laptop for college may seem like a rather large expense however, this is the primary tool of our trade. Having your own laptop capable of efficiently producing digital and print design work—in and out of the classroom—is not just an investment in your education but in your future.

Will financial aid cover it?

When should I buy one?

It is required to have your laptop purchased and ready for use by the first day of class. Planning ahead is crucial and you will want to purchase your laptop in advance of your intake into the program. If applicable, take advantage by asking for a laptop for the holidays or as a graduation gift.

Students are required to have a subscription to the Adobe Creative Cloud™. This subscription gives access to the full Adobe catalog but most importantly the primary software used within our program: Adobe Photoshop, Adobe Illustrator, Adobe InDesign, and Adobe Dreamweaver.

Students should have a subscription to the Creative Cloud, their memberships purchased, and software installed by the first day of classes.

Currently, the monthly price for the subscription at the student discount is set at: \$19.99/month.
