Program Completion

- **Generic Option** The full-time program track takes 5 quarters to complete, 150% = 8 quarters. The part-time track takes 9 quarters when maintained, 150% = 14 quarters
- **Licensed Practical Nurse [LPN]-to-ADN Option** The full-time program track takes 4 quarters to complete, 150% = 6 quarters. The part-time track takes 8 quarters when maintained, 150% = 12 quarters.

Expected Level of Achievement: Eighty-five percent (85%) of students will graduate in nine (9) quarters or less.
