



TRANSFER SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY

- Admissions application, application fee, scholarship application and up-to-date transcripts (including grades from previous term/semester) from all institutions attended must be sent to K-State by **November 1** for students starting in the spring and **February 1** for summer- or fall-starting students. Apply at k-state.edu/admissions
- Must have 24 or more transfer hours completed prior to arrival at K-State.
- Must be a full-time domestic student on either the Manhattan or Salina campus.
- Students may receive **only one** university transfer scholarship, but may receive PTK scholarship(s) in addition to the university award.
- Scholarship awards **are** stackable with departmental and college awards.
- Students who are readmitted (have attended K-State previously), have previously completed a bachelor's degree, or are international may be considered for college and departmental awards but are not eligible for transfer scholarships.

* A limited number of these scholarships will be selectively awarded to students with significant leadership experience who are transferring from a Kansas Community College.

- Transfer scholarship funding is limited for in-state awards, thus priority will be given to Kansas Community College students.

Additional Scholarships for PTK Members

PTK	\$500	3.5 Cumulative GPA and member during last semester prior to attending K-State (will be verified with state PTK association)
PTK Leadership	\$500	Meet criteria for PTK scholarship above and exhibit high leadership and involvement at current community college***
PTK- All Academic	\$500	Meet criteria for PTK scholarship above and be recognized by the society at state-level banquet

- One-time non-renewable awards for students transferring directly from community colleges
- In addition to one university award, students may be considered for the three PTK scholarships listed below
- Membership in PTK must be established and confirmed by the end of last FULL semester at transfer institution

***These scholarships will be selectively awarded based on student's scholarship application.



Midwest Student Exchange Agreement (for non-Kansas residents)

Must be a resident of Illinois, Indiana, Michigan, Minnesota, Missouri, Nebraska, North Dakota or Wisconsin. Awarded to students with a minimum 3.5 college GPA and enrolled in one of the qualifying curricula. Eligible students pay 150% of in-state tuition and must maintain a 3.0 GPA at K-State each semester for award renewal. Eligible curricula include:
