Summary: Currently in the state of Nebraska, the DANB- CDA Exam, which certifies dental assistants, is not required by statute in order to practice as dental assisting. However, if the dental assistant would like to become licensed in Nebraska and expand their scope of practice they must pass the board exam with a minimum of a 75%.
