

STOP Seward County



The County Attorney has the right to refuse or accept any individual.

You ARE eligible to take this class if the citation is for a Minor Traffic Violation. Examples:

- Speeding not more than 19 mph over posted limit
- Disregard traffic sign or signal
- Wrong way, wrong side or improper passing
- Failure to yield right of way
- Following too closely
- Driving too fast for conditions
- Improper turns, backing or lane changes
- Careless/negligent driving
- If you do not wish to contest your citation

Protect your driving record.

Avoid a court appearance.

You are NOT eligible to take this class if the citation is for a Major Traffic Violation. Examples:

- Leaving the scene of an accident
- Driving under the influence of alcohol/drugs
- Reckless driving or willful reckless driving
- Driving on suspended/revoked license
- Operating a motor vehicle to avoid arrest
- Participating in speed competition
- Refusing a breath or blood test
- Speeding 20 mph or more over the posted limit
- Violations classified as misdemeanor or felony
- Injury accident
- Multiple violations (except for)
 - Proof of insurance not in vehicle - Valid driver's license not on person
 - Not wearing a seatbelt - Valid registration not in vehicle
- Operating a motor vehicle without insurance or other proof of financial responsibility

Attend a 4-hour STOP class and minor traffic violations can be dismissed!

Please note: You are only eligible to take this class once every THREE YEARS throughout the state of Nebraska.

You must successfully pass the 4-Hour STOP class within 30 days after you receive the citation or you may become ineligible.

Any person who holds a commercial drivers license is NOT ELIGIBLE for a class to divert a traffic violation regardless how minor the offense or what type of vehicle was being driven at the time the violation occurs.

How to Begin:

1. Email **STOP@southeast.edu**. In the subject line of the email type **“STOP Seward County.”**
2. Required documentation you need to provide with your initial email:
 - a. A scanned copy of the citation. Sorry we can't accept a fax.
 - b. A scanned image of your operator's license; front side only.
3. You will register online (don't worry we'll provide step-by-step instructions) and you must have an email account.
