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ELECTIVE: Can be any Criminal Justice course that is not listed on the other side or ANY course approved by your advisor.

PROGRAM INFORMATION

1. Grade of "C" or higher is required in all CRIM classes to progress through the program
2. Grade of "D" can be accepted for non-CRIM classes; however, it is recommended to not have D's on transcripts. However, if the class is a pre-requisite; you will need a "C" or better to proceed to the next class.
3. GPA of 2.0 is required for graduation
4. A criminal background check will be required of each student participating in an internship. Based on the outcome of the background check, a student may be prevented from obtaining an internship and/or completing a program. A non-refundable fee of \$45 will be assessed for the CBC. (This fee will follow the current fee schedule). Keep in mind if you do not complete an internship you will not be required to complete a background check; however, if you have a criminal record this could prevent you from obtaining employment in this career field.
5. It is recommended that you schedule an advising appointment with an advisor when scheduling classes. You **MUST** see an advisor and have your elective approved if it is not a criminal justice course before registering.
6. **GRADUATION:** You **MUST** make an appointment with the Program Chair of Criminal Justice to have your program reviewed and approved prior to you seeking graduation. You **MUST** have the Program Chair of Criminal Justice complete an Application of Graduation that you will need to provide to the registrar seeking graduation. **IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE STUDENT TO ASK/NOTIFY THE PROGRAM CHAIR YOU ARE CLOSE TO GRADUATION AND YOU NEED AN APPLICATION COMPLETED.**
