The admission checklist will assist you in completing the online Health Sciences application. Please complete the following requirements prior to submitting your application to the program.

Select Program Option

- LPN-to-ADN Full-time:** The traditional track is offered on Lincoln and Beatrice Campuses and accepts new students once per year. Full-time students are admitted in the in the spring term. Clinical sites are in the Lincoln and surrounding areas.

- LPN-to-ADN Part-time:** This track is offered only on Lincoln campus. Part-time students are admitted in the fall term. Clinical sites are in Lincoln and surrounding areas.

- Complete Program and General Education Requirements:** Students must receive a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.75 in the sciences and 2.5 in general education courses for admission into the program. Courses can be taken at SCC or any accredited college/university and must meet SCC requirement for transfer.

- Complete Program Admission Criteria Requirements** (see program admission criteria for details)
 - LPN license (active, and unencumbered)
 - Professional Resume
 - NACE-1 is required if graduated from an LPN program three or more years ago. Information about NACE-1 can be found on the program website. It must be completed within 1 year prior to application.
- Request Official Transcripts** from other college/universities if transferring courses to SCC. Have transcripts sent directly to the SCC Admissions Office, 8800 O Street Lincoln, NE 68520.
- Complete Program Application** Online application link will be available during the application period noted below. Application period for the Associate Degree Nursing program:
Spring Term: November 1st to December 15th **Acceptance Notification Date:** January 15th

Special Program Requirements: Submit at the time of completing application to the Health Sciences Office (Room B4):

- Proof of current CPR for Healthcare Providers American Heart Certification
- Complete Student Health Statement (see documentation form on program webpage)
- Complete current Tuberculosis two-step skin test (see documentation form on program webpage)
