



Associate Degree Nursing Program LPN to ADN option *Admission Criteria*

Admission into the SCC Associate Degree Nursing (ADN to LPN option) program is competitive. A committee will review all submitted applications and assign points based on a pre-determined scoring rubric. This point system will be used to rank each applicant based on specific criteria (see below).

Applicants will receive points for the following items:

Academic Performance	Points are given based on GPA	2
Repeated Courses	No repetition of courses due to failure or withdrawal	1
Unsuccessful/ Failed Program(s) Attempts	No previous history of not completing other Health Science Division (HSD) program(s)	1
Professional Awareness	Must have an active, unencumbered LPN license	1
Professional Resume	Points awarded to specific areas listed (see rubric)	4

Academic Performance:

GPA and grades earned in prerequisite courses are considered. Minimum GPA requirements are a 2.75 in science courses (Human Anatomy w/ lab, Microbiology w/ lab, Human Physiology w/ lab Chemistry w/ lab) and a 2.5 in the remaining prerequisite courses. (See admission checklist for detailed information regarding prerequisite courses.)

Repeated Courses:

Evidence of no repeated/withdrawn course(s) within the last five (5) years. Points are given based on NO repetition of courses. Withdrawals and failure to pass a course counts as repetition.

Unsuccessful Attempt/Withdrawal:

No unsuccessful program attempts within the last five (5) years. Withdrawing or not completing another Health Science Division program(s) will result in no points given in this category.

Professional Awareness:

Must have an active, unencumbered LPN license (an unencumbered license is a license that is not revoked, suspended, or made probationary or conditional by the licensing or registering authority in the respective jurisdiction as a result of disciplinary action).

Professional Resume:

A professional resume is required. Points may be given based on work experience and earned degrees. Healthcare experience, community and/or military service may also be listed if greater than 6 months. Random audits may be performed so resume must list the institutions' name, address, and phone number to receive point(s).

Applications Submitted Post-Deadline:

Completed applications received after the application deadline will be considered by the program review committee on a rolling basis as space is available.
