
SCC Paramedic Program Admission Checklist

The admission checklist will assist you in completing the online Health Sciences application. Please complete the following requirements prior to submitting your application to the program.

- Select Program Option:**
 - Face to Face:** The full-time traditional track is offered on the Lincoln campus and accepts new students one time per year in the fall term. The face to face track is three semesters (12 months). Clinical sites are in Lincoln and surrounding areas.
 - Hybrid:** The part-time hybrid track offers classroom instruction in an online format with lab sessions being offered on campus. New students are accepted every fall term. The online track is 4 semesters (24 months) and 2 summer terms.
- Meet with Health Sciences Advisor:** Schedule an appointment with Becky Kramer at 402-437-2688 or healthprograms@southeast.edu. To make the most of your advising appointment bring your placement scores and college transcripts if applicable.
- Complete Placement Testing** or provide testing scores taken within past 5 years. To schedule appointment for testing, contact the SCC Testing Center. The program requires the following placement testing scores for admission:

 COMPASS reading score of 61
 ACT reading score of 14
 ASSET reading score of 36
 SAT reading score of 350

Writing Placement:

Accup Sentence Skills 64
 COMPASS writing score of 52
 ACT writing score of 16
 ASSET writing score of 39
 SAT writing score of 390
 Inter College Reading/Writing (ENGL0985) or higher

- Complete Program and General Education Requirements:** Students must receive a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.5 in the four prerequisite courses for admission into the program. Courses can be taken at SCC or any accredited college/university and must meet SCC requirement for transfer.
