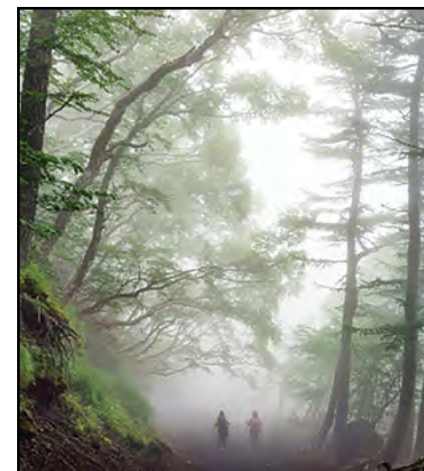

7. Enter your **payment information**. Click **Submit**.
