Macramé is back and updated in a new, fresh form! In this class you will make a wall hanging that will be ready to show off and hang from four basic knots you can expand and make all kinds of art, as well as rugs, plant hangers, jewelry, purses, hammocks, etc. Start out with a twelve-inch dowel and make an art piece out of cotton cord. The new freer form of macramé is more artistic than the tight craft patterns of the 1970s.

Bring a fine tooth comb to comb out some of the cord for an additional decorative touch. Also bring sharp scissors. Elaine, the instructor, has done macramé for more than 40 years. 
Learning to Paint Like Bob Ross: Winter Wreath Scene

There is a \$25 supply fee payable in class. Check or cash only for supplies. A 30-minute lunch break on your own. A sack lunch and beverage are recommended.



NEW! Quilting for Beginners

Do you want to learn to quilt but have limited time? Learn the basics of quilting (cutting, piecing, quilting, and binding) as you construct a table topper or baby quilt, it all depends on your fabric selection. Best of all, you will have acquired the needed skills to make almost any quilt pattern!

Bring to class: Sewing machine in good working order along with the user's manual, 1/4-inch foot if available, rotary cutter, 6-inch by 24-inch ruler, and basic sewing supplies. Fabric needed: 5/8 yard background fabric, 1/2 yard fabric choice two, 1 yard of fabric choice 3, 1/3 yard fabric for binding, and cotton batting measuring at least 43 inches by 43 inches. In choosing your fabrics, look for a light, medium and dark values for a pleasing combination.
