- The University Registrar and/or respective Department Chair at Nebraska Wesleyan will conduct a course-by-course evaluation of official transcripts to apply courses to general education, academic major, and degree requirements.
- Courses must have a grade of C- or higher to be eligible for transfer. Equivalent social work courses must have a grade of C+ or better to be eligible for transfer.
- A minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher is required to take social work classes at NWU
- Students must complete a total of 126 semester hours to earn a bachelor's degree from NWU. A maximum of 64 semester hours can be transferred from SCC.
