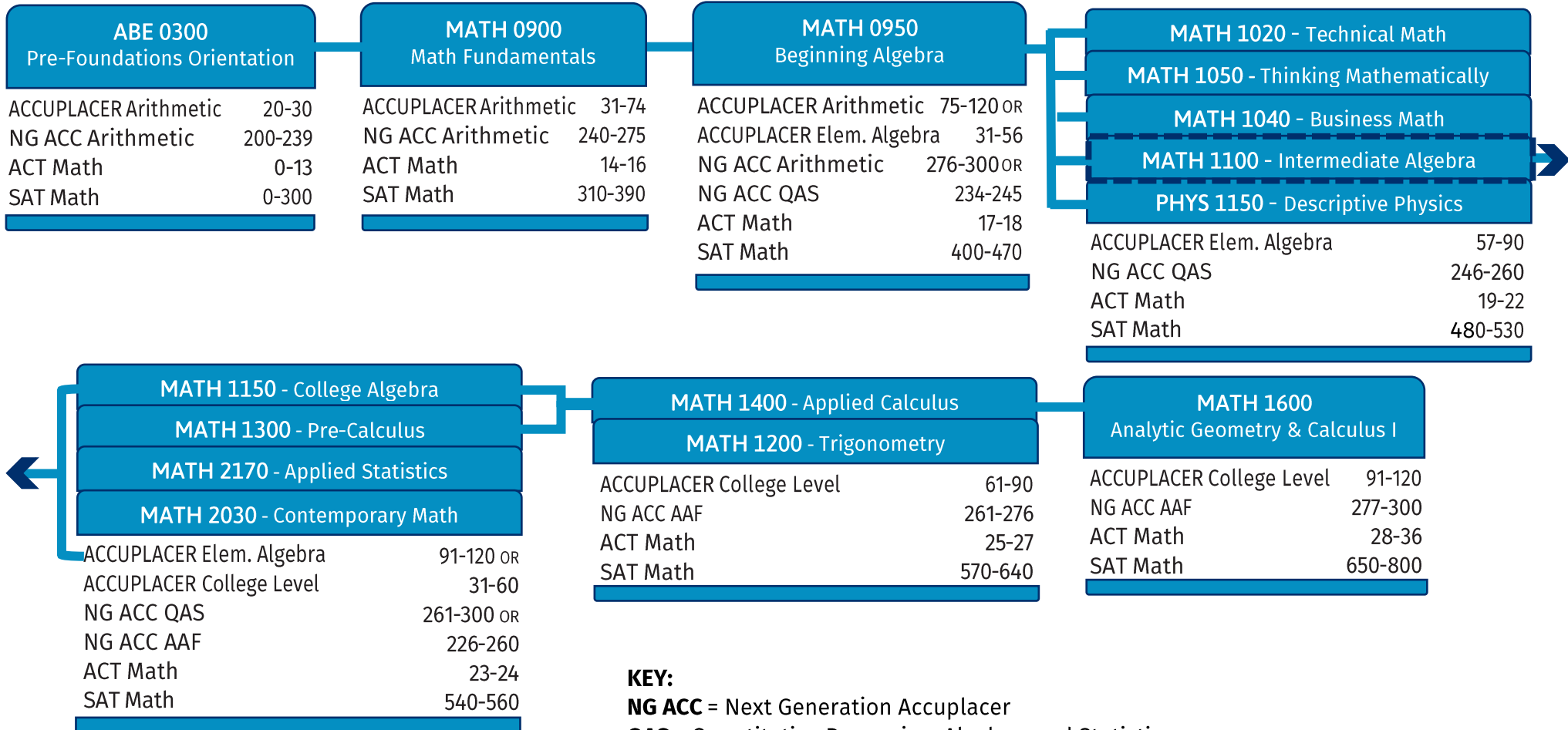


MATH COURSE PLACEMENT

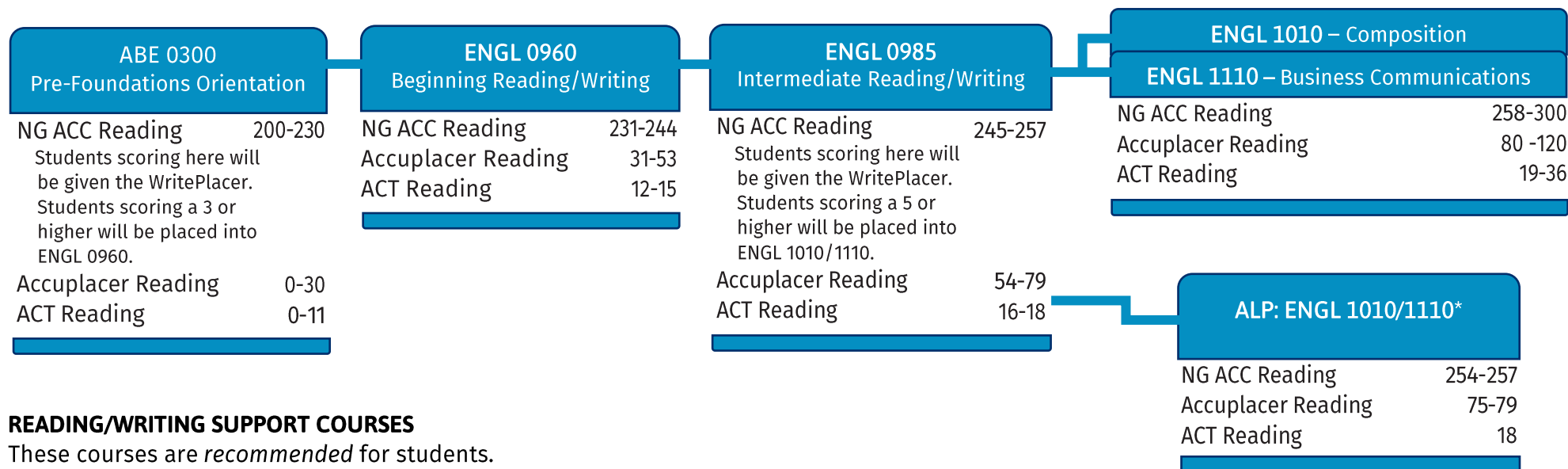
