



Interpreter Training

SCC has classes to help you improve your language interpreting skills.

SCC offers several courses focusing on skills training for interpreters. All new students must register for ESL Orientation to determine if they are eligible to enroll in the interpreter training class.

To register for ESL Orientation, come to SCC, Room J-2, 8800 O St., Lincoln.

The Role of the Interpreter & Translator

Prerequisite: Completion of secondary education (high school) AND placement into ESL Level 9 on the SCC ESL Placement Test

This practice-oriented course will immediately immerse the students in focused discussions, lectures and problem solving activities that highlight the everyday issues faced in interpreting. The goal of the course is to educate the students about ethical behavior: what it means to be a “professional” and how these key proficiencies play an integral role in being a skilled and competent interpreter. It also will lay the foundation for additional SCC interpreter training courses.

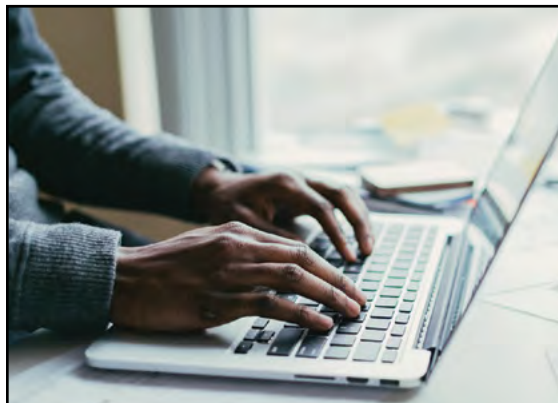

Adult Education Grant-Funded ESL (Free)

These non-credit ESL classes are for people who want to improve their English language skills: speaking, listening, reading, and writing, to participate more fully in everyday life in their community and at work. These classes require a great commitment to attend all class sessions. Adult Education-funded ESL classes are open to students of all English abilities.

All new students, and students who have been out of the Adult Education-funded ESL program for 6 months or longer, must attend an ESL Orientation. Please come to SCC, Room J-2, 8800 O St., Lincoln, to register for ESL Orientation.

Advanced & Professional English Communication ESL

Students who can already communicate in English can continue improving their English speaking and writing skills in Advanced and Professional English Communication ESL courses. Students pay tuition and purchase the required books for the classes. In these ESL classes, instructors guide the students to strengthen their skills in:

- Conversational English
- Grammar Development
- Professional Writing
- Reading and Vocabulary

All new students must attend an ESL Orientation before registering for class. For more information, call 402-437-2840 or visit www.southeast.edu/ESL.

Students who have not previously enrolled in the SCC ESL program or have been out of the program for six months or more must go to 8800 O St., Room J-2, Lincoln, to register for the ESL Orientation.

After you have registered for an ESL class, you must go to the first class session. You must call 402-437-2840 or 800-642-4075, ext. 2840, immediately if you decide NOT to attend the ESL class for which you registered. You must call the day before the class begins to officially drop the class and receive a full tuition refund. If you call the day the class starts or later, you will not receive a tuition refund. Each student must bring the required book(s) to every class.
