

# SCC Book Club

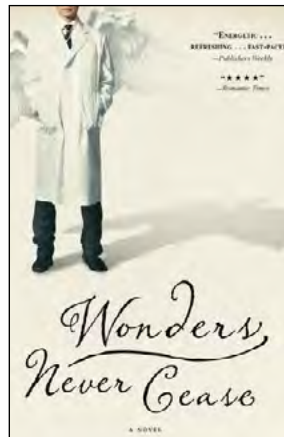

*Thursday, May 14, 2020*

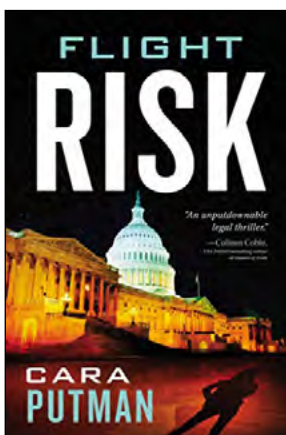
