4th-8th Grade

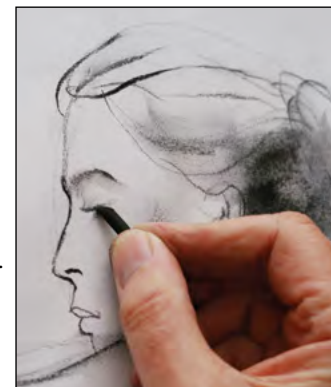
Encouraging fundamental development for improvement in every aspect of the game, this class will help basketball players with drills to help improve their game.

You must have an email account to register online.

- Search for your class** by entering a **key word** in the title or the **course number**. Click **Submit**. (Enter information in only one field for broader results.)

Course Number Example: *TRAN-3398*
- Select the course** for which you wish to register. Click **Submit**.
- Enter your **personal information, certify your identification** and click **Submit**.  
\* You must provide your Social Security Number.
- Optional:** Enter your **Additional Registration Information** and click **Submit**.

- If you want to register for additional classes, select **Search for more classes** under "Choose one of the following." If you are finished selecting the class(es) for which you want to register, select **Register now (check out)**. Select your **Payment Type**. Click **Submit**.
- Enter your **payment information**. Click **Submit**.
