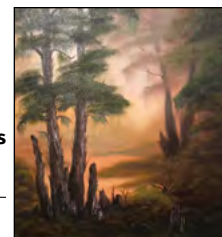

5. *Optional*: Enter your **Additional Registration Information** and click **Submit**.
