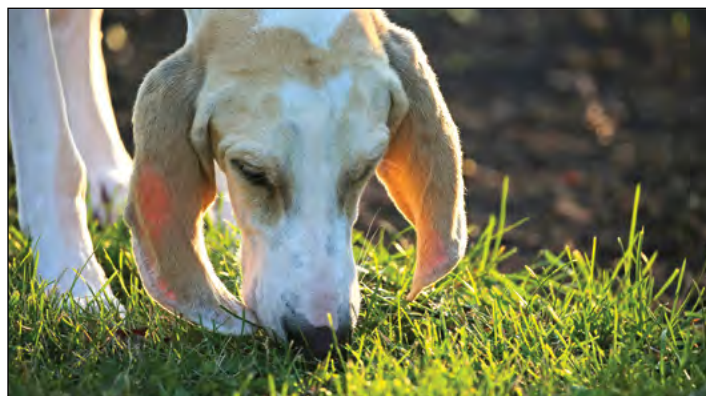
## Introduction to Rally Obedience
