### ELIGIBILITY

Your application will be considered and cross-referenced for [all scholarships](#) for which you qualify – you don't have to pre-select your scholarships of interest!

### APPLICATION

- Only [online](#) application forms will be accepted at [www.southeast.edu/scholarships](http://www.southeast.edu/scholarships).
- Applicant must create an account then complete the **online application** for High School Seniors - ONLY.
- Use a **personal email** address as opposed to a school account.
- In order to be considered for all SCC scholarships, the applicant must provide a copy of his/her **high school transcript** to [admissions@southeast.edu](mailto:admissions@southeast.edu). Transcript should include a **cumulative grade-point average** (and class ranking when available.)

### SCHOLARSHIP SELECTION

- The SCC Educational Foundation awards scholarships to high school seniors, to be applied toward educational costs, when a student is accepted and enrolled in a degree or diploma program at SCC.
- The SCC Scholarship Committee will select the recipients.
- Scholarship recipients will be notified via email.

For graduating high school seniors who have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher who live in the 15-county area.
