Included in this course are classroom and nursing lab experiences in a health care setting.

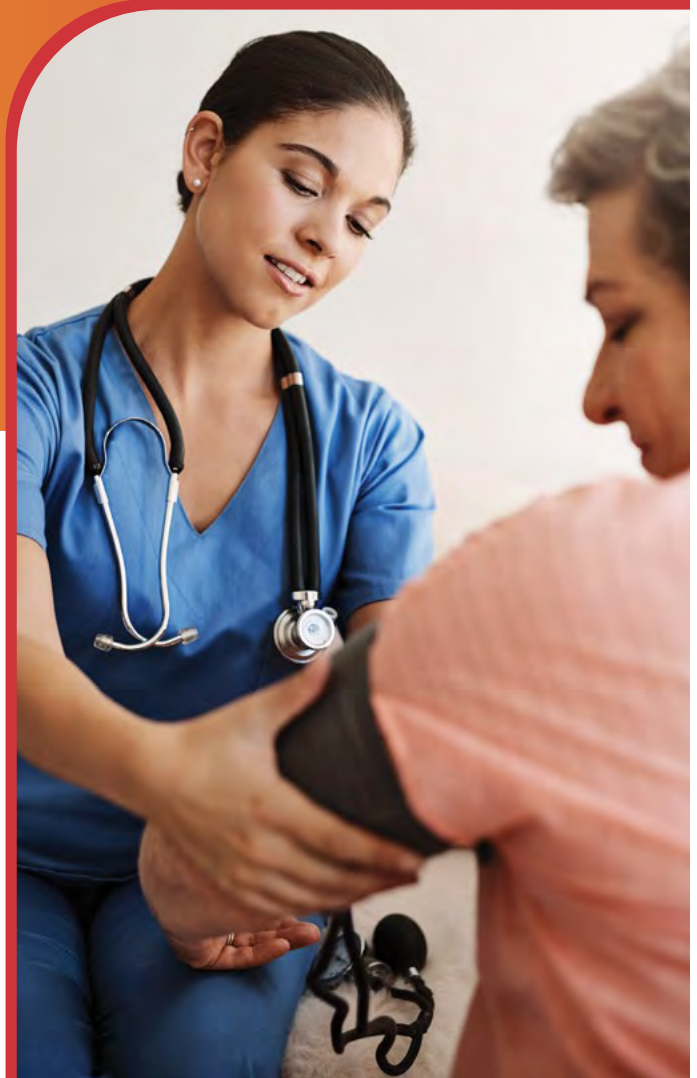
