



## **Mobile Off-Road Equipment Class**

Class 7 rough terrain lift truck operator certification will be included in the course. Safe operation, construction, function, diagnosis, service, and repair topics in this course will be followed by hands on tasks in the Laboratory course. Concurrent with or separate from the Lab hands-on course (AGST-1031 lab).

You will be notified of your results. If you pass, then you may register.
