Full Color Process

This version should be used in most applications where only the head needs to be displayed. It is also suitable for applications where the mascot will be shown at a very small size, such as a web browser icon, mobile app icon, social media profile image, and more.






This version is recommended for applications where the full body of the mascot needs to be displayed. It is particularly suitable for larger application sizes where the details of the head features should not be lost.




2-Color Dark and Light Blue Process










This secondary mark can be used in place of the mascot or wordmark. The paw print also works well for vertical and square formats for small size applications including icons.




2-Color Dark and Light Blue Process



Clear Space + Guidelines

Clear space is the minimum "breathing room" that must be maintained around the logo.

This clearance—on all versions of the lockups—should be equal to or more than twice the line height of 'Southeast Community College,' as indicated here.

Much effort has been made to create a custom design with consistent letter spacing, line spacing, and alignment of elements. **NEVER** rearrange the copy, adjust the line spacing or letter spacing. **NEVER** alter, redraw, distort, or rebuild the logo in any case.

The logo must always be recognizable and readable. Never display at a size too small for legibility. There is a large family of logo variations for optimum display at any size.



Formats Explained

The following instructions describe when to use the different color and file formats provided in this brand guide.

PANTONE (PMS or SPOT)

The Pantone Matching System is an extensive library of standardized color swatches that ensure consistency in color when working in print. Typically, these logo formats are used in press printing for large quantity print runs where exact color matching is needed.

When working with a printer or vendor, they may specifically request your unique Pantone colors or Pantone logo files. This format is not meant for use in digital applications or on the web.

CMYK

The CMYK color format is used when working in print. This format is typically used in digital printing for small quantity print runs, or where specific color matching is not needed. This format is not meant for use in digital applications or on the web.

RGB & HEX

RGB and HEX color values are used for display on the web and in digital applications. This format is not meant for use in print applications.

EPS

The file format .EPS is what is known as a vector graphic. This file type is only used for design and printing purposes and may be requested when working with a printer or vendor. Designers, printers, and vendors can open and edit this file type using specialized design software.

PNG

The file format .PNG can be used and opened universally by any user. It is meant for use on the web, and in digital applications.
